<u>If you are a student</u>

- 3. Your diploma is value-added. Being successfully accredited, MCU is listed, along with other fine American institutes. Our graduates (= you), sharing the same glory, are empowered with better career development and self-learning capacities.





WHAT DOES A U.S. INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION MEAN TO ME?

<u>If you are a faculty member</u>

- 1. After the accreditation, you have structured your teaching and research routines around the evaluation practices and kept up the momentum of self-improvement. That fosters the establishment of accreditation climate university-wide.
- 2. After the accreditation, you have solid references to evaluate the learning outcomes and improve the teaching methods.
- 3. After the stimulus of accreditation, your teaching resources will be diversified.

If you are administrative staff

- 1. Your participation guides you to refer the 7 MSCHE standards for your administrative work, which helps align your work quality with the university mission and goals.
- 2. Your participation provokes thoughts on the skills and methods applied to administrative services and on suitable rubrics which help refine service quality and maximize outcomes.
